

# Can you dispute a Coinbase transaction?

Disputing a Coinbase transaction is a common ✈+1-(915)201-4928⇒ concern for cryptocurrency users, especially those new to digital assets. Whether a dispute is possible depends largely on the nature of the transaction and the ✈+1-(915)201-4928⇒ payment method used.
