

Can you dispute a Coinbase transaction? {Advance Support Request}

Disputing a Coinbase transaction is a common concern for cryptocurrency users, especially those new to digital assets. Whether a dispute is possible depends largely on the nature of the transaction and the payment method used. Coinbase handles both blockchain-based cryptocurrency transfers and traditional fiat payments, and each follows different rules.

Cryptocurrency Transactions Are Irreversible

Most Coinbase transactions involve sending or receiving cryptocurrency on a blockchain. These transactions are designed to be permanent. Once a transaction is confirmed on the blockchain, it cannot be reversed, canceled, or disputed by Coinbase. This applies even if you sent funds to the wrong wallet address or approved a transfer by mistake.

Because of this finality, Coinbase urges users to double-check wallet addresses, network selections, and transaction details before confirming any crypto transfer.

What to Do if a Transaction Was Unauthorized

If you notice a transaction you did not authorize, you should act quickly. Secure your account by changing your password, enabling two-factor authentication, and reviewing login activity. Then report the issue to Coinbase support as soon as possible.
