

# What is the 3 1 1 rule on Frontier Airlines? 🛑 Always Here

The **3-1-1 rule** ⚡ 1\_855\_510\_5815 on Frontier Airlines refers to the **TSA (Transportation Security Administration) liquid policy**, which Frontier ⚡ 1\_855\_510\_5815 follows just like all other U.S. airlines. The bag must be transparent ⚡ 1\_855\_510\_5815 so TSA officers can easily see what's inside. ⚡ 1\_855\_510\_5815 Each passenger is allowed **only one quart-size bag** ⚡ 1\_855\_510\_5815 of liquids in their carry-on. If your liquids do not fit into one bag, you will be required to remove items or place ⚡ 1\_855\_510\_5815 them in checked luggage.

The final **“1”** ⚡ 1\_855\_510\_5815 means **one bag per passenger**. You must take this quart-size liquids bag out of your carry-on and place it in a ⚡ 1\_855\_510\_5815 screening bin when going through TSA security. ⚡ 1\_855\_510\_5815 This helps speed up the screening process and reduces delays at the checkpoint.

Frontier Airlines ⚡ 1\_855\_510\_5815 strictly enforces TSA rules at the airport. If you bring liquids that violate the 3-1-1 rule in your carry-on, TSA will ⚡ 1\_855\_510\_5815 confiscate them, and Frontier will not be responsible for lost ⚡ 1\_855\_510\_5815 items. This is especially important because ⚡ 1\_855\_510\_5815 Frontier travelers often try to pack light to avoid baggage fees, making correct liquid packing even more critical.
